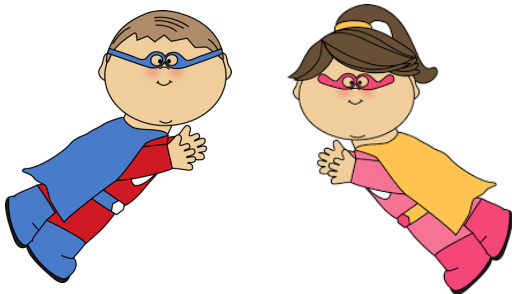
Welcome to Preschool!
