

Frequently Asked Questions

Can PreKindergarten students attend after school care?

Yes! All PreK students are able to attend after school care. The cost for after school care is \$20 per day (siblings get a discount rate of \$10 per day).

Are PreKindergarten students eligible for the bus?

PreK students are not eligible for bus service. This is consistent with the policies for Downers Grove District 58 which offers bussing services for students beginning in Kindergarten.

Will PreKindergarten students eat lunch?

Yes, PreK students will eat both a snack and a lunch. Lunches will be provided by parents and brought to school with your child(ren) on Mondays, Wednesday, and Fridays. PreK students are able to order hot lunch on Tuesdays and Thursdays as well. If parents choose not to order hot lunch for their child(ren) on those days, they will need to send their child(ren) to school with a lunch.

Will PreKindergarten students attend Mass?

At this time only students in grades Kindergarten through 8th will attend the weekly school Mass.

Does the PreKindergarten program include options for summer care?

There are no plans for summer care at St. Mary of Gostyn as of now.
