Dear St. Mary of Gostyn Parishioner:

As I became the new Pastor of St. Mary of Gostyn this past July, I am most thankful to Fr. Jim Schwab and all our previous Pastors for their servant leadership since the foundation of our parish in 1891. St. Mary's is a vibrant parish with many ministries where we all grow as a family of faith. I am delighted to be here to continue our rich heritage and many traditions as we desire a life-long relationship with Jesus Christ and His Catholic Church.

Community has always been a strength at St. Mary's. We began our fall ministries with a welcome back barbeque, an ice cream social to begin our school year, and a 5K race for our community to support our school. At the heart of community is worship at Mass where we receive the Real Presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist: Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. The Lord's Day and Sunday Mass are the foundation by which Jesus Christ unites us as his disciples for eternal life.

Why is Sunday, the Lord's Day, different than any other day of the week? Is the Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ central to my life as a Catholic Christian?

Jesus Christ calls us to go deeper, and he promises to restore and renew his people. Our world is hurting. We all need healing, yet many of us are separated from the very source of our strength, which is Jesus in the Eucharist. Jesus invites us to return to the source and summit of our faith by participating in the celebration of the Eucharist. Nothing is more significant than our loving Triune God, who desires our salvation. The Church exists for the salvation of souls. Our number one priority at St. Mary's is the gift of eternal life for all our families.

We invite you to return if you have been away from our Sunday Masses at St. Mary's these last few years. We miss you, and we love you. St. Mary's is not the same without you. We strive to be a welcoming community, and your presence brings great joy when we gather as Church, the Body of Christ, and we see friendly faces in the pews. We understand some of you are not able to join us due to health concerns; please be assured of our prayers for you. May we remain open to the Holy Spirit as we thank God for his transformative love for us. May the peace of Jesus Christ bring joy to your life as we encounter his Real Presence in the Eucharist at Sunday Mass. 
