





Adoration Chapel Advent /Christmas Adoration chapel will be closed Saturday. December 23rd and will reopen Wednesday, December 27th.

St Vincent DePaul Food Pantry November Update

Once again, the food pantry was blessed to have donations from St. Mary's families. The Religious Ed families donated food and hygiene items during their annual Thanksgiving drive. Thanks to them the shelves continue to be filled, and we can serve our neighbors with a variety of can goods, dry goods, and paper products. Our neighbors also received Aldi gifts cards for purchases for their Thanksgiving dinners thanks to generous parishioners and the monetary donations made to SVDP. An average of 37 families are being supported weekly by the food pantry. Thanks to the loyal contributors to the pantry and the families of the Religious Ed students, we can continue to provide healthy food for our neighbors.

This past month St Mary's Food Pantry served 550 individuals within 189 families to bring the yearly totals to 4415 individuals within 1,583 families.

Although our shelves are stocked now, we will go through those items quickly! If you are able to pick up and drop off the needed items listed below you will be instrumental in our mission to help local families. Most needed items are regular size bottles of laundry detergent, canned spaghetti sauce, chili, tuna, fruit, corn, peas and mixed vegetables. Please add a couple of these items to your shopping carts each week. Pantry donations are accepted on Wednesdays from 8:00 am to 11:00 am when the pantry is open or the food barrels in church may be used.

SVDP donation envelopes are also available at the church entrances. Please consider making a monetary donation to the pantry directly by placing your envelope in the Sunday's collection. Monetary donations are used to purchase items that the pantry is low on.
