



### **PADS MINISTRY**

St Mary's supports DuPage PADS through monthly gift card drives, which are used to help those staying at the Interim Housing Center (IHC) in Downers Grove. The IHC has tripled PADS capacity for interim housing, currently 321 people, including 118 children. PADS arranges for cribs, formula and diapers, and helps families get to the pediatrician and other early-childhood services. Next gift card drive is Friday, January 19th, 5-6PM in the parking lot.



### St Vincent DePaul Food Pantry December Update

The Food Pantry continued to provide food and supplies to many neighbors during the month of December. A large donation of food and cash came from Frank N. Szafranski, CFP®, CRPC®, Private Wealth Advisor with Ameriprise Financial Services, LLC along with frequent donations found in the church bins or dropped off at the pantry. One thousand dollars in gift cards were donated to the pantry and were distributed to our patrons for Christmas. The generosity to the food pantry has the shelves stocked for January. On behalf of the patrons, SVDP thanks all of those who contributed.

This month St Mary's Food Pantry served 401 individuals within 133 families to bring the yearly totals to 4816 individuals within 1716 families. Now that the holidays are over, the pantry is sure to see an increase in families and individuals.

If you are able to pick up and drop off the needed items listed you will be instrumental in our mission to help local families. Without scheduled food drives, the pantry will need the help of St. Mary's parishioners. Most needed items are canned fruit, canned peas, canned mixed vegetables and regular size laundry detergent or dish soap. Regular size items are the best to donate.
