




Week: 11 Featured Saint: Saint Maximilian Kolbe Feast Day: August 14

BECOMING CATHOLIC









Important Update for Parishioners: Action Required Regarding CMAA InPew Envelopes

The Development Office of the Diocese of Joliet is committed to maintaining transparency and open communication with our parishioners. We wish to provide an important update concerning the status of the Catholic Ministries Annual Appeal (CMAA) InPew Envelopes. As many of you are aware, we encountered an unexpected challenge with UPS back in March, which resulted in the loss of 23 packages containing InPew Envelopes, many with checks made out to the CMAA. To date, UPS has been unable to locate these missing packages. In light of this situation, we strongly advise parishioners who made a gift via check using an InPew Envelope to verify their transaction with their bank.

If you find that your check has not been cashed, we recommend you take the necessary steps to stop payment on that check. FOOD PANTRY NEWS

During the month of July, the food pantry served 456 individuals in 179 families. Over 1000 families have been provided weekly food staples during the first seven months of 2025. Each week one or two more neighbors register at the pantry to receive food assistance.

The food pantry staff is grateful for the donations from St. Mary parishioners. These donations are what stock the shelves in the food pantry, but donations have slowed down during the summer months. The pantry's supplies are very low.

When you do your weekly grocery shopping, please pick up a few items for the pantry. Why not take advantage of the multiple item deals at the grocery stores – buy one for yourself and donate the other item to the pantry. The most needed items are: cans of chili, fruit, soup, beans, spaghetti sauce, as well as dry pasta and Ramen Noodles packages Please donate <u>REGULAR</u> <u>SIZE</u> grocery items. Large items cannot be split, as it is required that the items that are distributed all have labels. Check the Monday eBlast to see the weekly shortages.


