

FOOD PANTRY NEWS

The food pantry continues to assist close to 40 families each week, totally over 350 individuals. As we enter the fall season, we are registering one – two new families each week. To successfully serve them, help from our St. Mary's community is crucial.

Keeping the pantry stocked in September required volunteers to shop for many items that were low. Our stock is dependent on the generous donation from St. Mary's parishioners. Food and household products are most appreciated and donated cash allows us to purchase items we are low on.

When you do your weekly grocery shopping, please pick up a few items for the pantry. Multiple item deals at the grocery stores allow you to buy one for yourself and donate the other item to the pantry. The most needed items are: cans of vegetables, fruit, soup, prepared can pastas as well as pasta, rice, or potato side dishes and coffee. Coffee is a staple for many of our senior neighbors and requested regularly. Please donate REGULAR SIZE grocery items. Large items cannot be split, as it is required that the items that are distributed have a label and are in original packaging. The pantry can't distribute open items. Check the Monday eBlast to see the weekly shortages.






