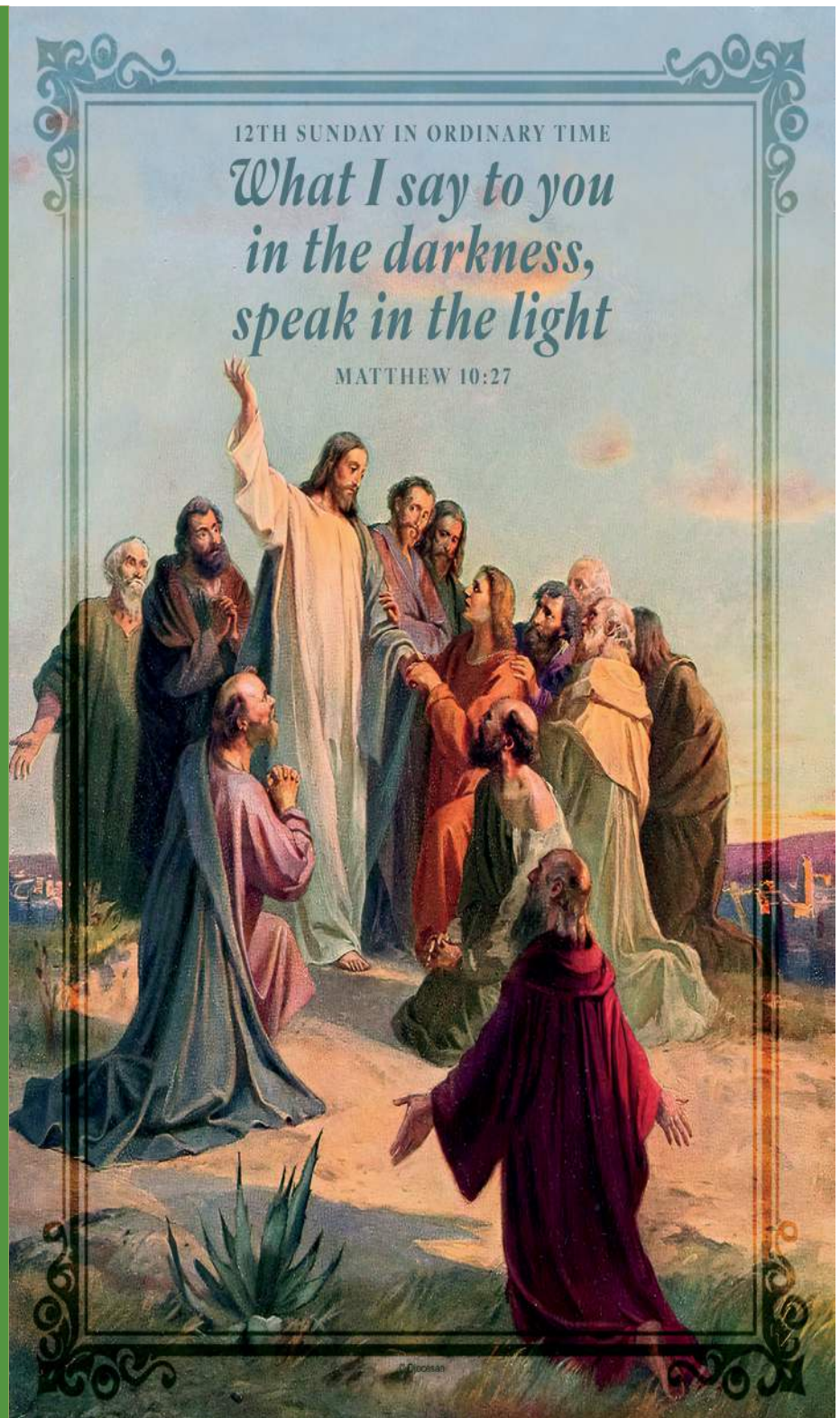

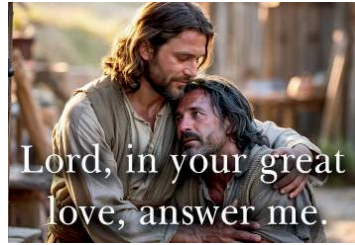

# SUMMER MASS ATTIRE

Dear Parishioners:

As we approach the summer months, some gentle reminders about our Mass attire can be helpful. As you know, the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith. When we gather in church, we enter the house of God, not simply another public place, but a sacred place where heaven touches earth.

It has become noticeable that our standards of dress at Mass have become more casual, and at times, immodest or distracting. I know that this is rarely intentional; however, it is important that we reflect on how our clothing expresses our reverence for God and our consideration for one another.

We live in a culture where casual attire is the norm, and there is nothing wrong with comfort. Yet, when we come before the Lord, truly present in the Eucharist, it is fitting to offer our best. Dressing modestly and respectfully is not about judgment or vanity, but about acknowledging the appropriateness of our appearance and actions and helping each other maintain a spirit of prayer.

As we prepare to attend Mass, I ask each of us to choose clothing that reflects reverence for the Church as a holy place. Both men and women are encouraged to dress in a modest manner, selecting attire that is dignified and does not draw unnecessary attention to oneself. In this spirit, it is best to avoid clothing that is overly casual or revealing, such as midriff or spaghetti strap tops, tight-fitting garments, beach attire, or items with inappropriate graphics or messages. When there is any uncertainty, I encourage you to choose what reflects modesty, dignity, and respect for our sacred place.

This is not a call to formal fashion or to burden anyone financially. It is a reminder that our outward appearance can help foster an interior disposition of worship. Our attire can help us understand we are here to encounter, Our Lord Jesus Christ. Let us remember that when we gather for Mass, we stand among the angels and saints offering praise to the King of Heaven. May our attire, our hearts, and our actions reflect that profound reality of faith.

Thank you for your understanding and love for our St. Mary's community. Let us continue to build a culture of reverence, charity, and joyful praise together. Please be assured of my prayers for you and your families.

## Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In the tradition of the Church, not necessarily in your own life's timeline, confirmation is the midpoint of Christian initiation, standing between font and table. Full initiation is completed when a confirmed person shares in the Eucharist. Centuries ago, this first sharing in the eucharistic assembly was marked by a first sharing in the Prayer of the Faithful. This prayer raises up the needs of the church and human community, the concerns of the faithful assembled, as they prepare to lift up the world to the Father's love. So a person could not participate in the prayer until they were anointed with the "Oil of Thanksgiving." Next, the newly baptized presented their gifts at the altar, a sure sign of their investment in a new way of life. Until the sixth century, these people normally drank a mixture of milk and honey as a kind of pre-Communion. They were hungry, of course, since they were baptized hungry after long fasting, but this beautiful symbol of the promised land revealed them as God's chosen, heirs to the promise. Although the "milk shake" disappeared centuries ago, we still see the vigor of this new life whenever adults are initiated at Easter, and increasingly in confirmation ceremonies that are attentive to this meaning.

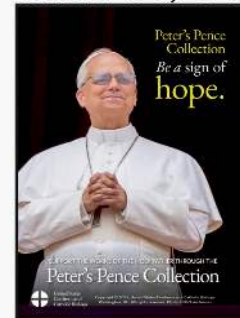
The Diocese of Joliet invites all parishioners to support the 2026 Catholic Ministries Annual Appeal (CMAA). Together, we can make a profound difference.
